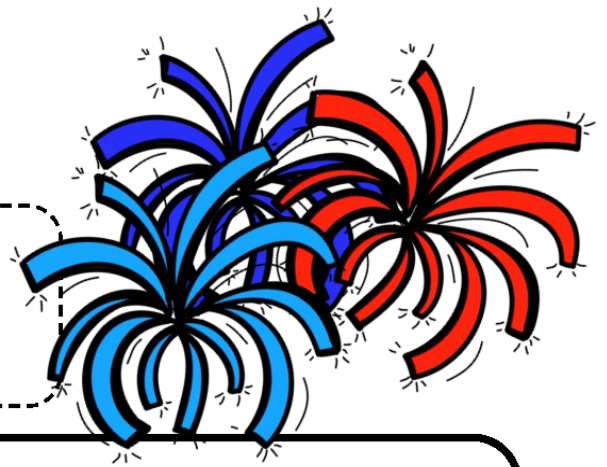

As we move into the month of July, we will focus the first week on the 4th of July. We will be putting together Fourth of July puzzles, creating flag collages, and making firework paintings.

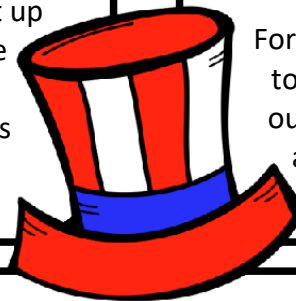
