## Day care committee begins fund-raising

The fund drive for a day care center in Elkhorn's Business Park has gone into motion. The Elkhorn Day Care Committee has planned a variety of fund-raising events in the next 2 months.

President of the committee, Larry Geisler, announced in February that Lakeland Little Learners, a non-profit corporation, will be the provider for the new center. Little Learners presently operates out of Lakeland Nursing Home.

The new facility will accommodate 135 full-time positions, and will break even by filling 95. Little

Learners can deliver 70 full-time children and 65 would be available to the community.

The total project will cost an estimated \$350,000. Fund-raising is needed to reach this goal.

The first fund-raiser is a 3 - 6 - 9 Bowling Tournament. All bowlers are invited to attend this event which will be held April 15 and 16 at Two Seasons Bowling Alley, Elkhorn. Those with an established average are asked to bring that information. Those without established averages will be given one.

The times available are April 15, 6:30 p.m. or 9 p.m. for adults only. The times available on April 16 are 1 or 3:30 p.m. Families are welcome to the April 16 tournament.

Anyone signing up 20 or more bowlers can bowl free as a squad leader.

Entry fee is \$12 per bowler. Reservations are suggested by calling 723-4047.

Bingo is the fund-raising event planned for Sunday, April 24, at the Monte Carlo Room. Sponsored by Lakeland Little Learners and the

Monte Carlo Room, the event consists of two sessions. The first begins at 2 p.m. and concludes at 5 p.m. The second round begins at 6 p.m. and winds down at 9 p.m. The public is invited to attend either or both sessions.

On Sunday, May 8, the proceeds of the Mother's Day breakfast buffet at the Monte Carlo Room will benefit the Lakeland's Little Learners Building Fund. The buffet will be served from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. The cost is \$7.50 adults, \$3.25 children age 6 to 11 and \$1 for children 5 and under.
