Describing what is wet versus what is dry and letting the older children touch things that are wet and things that are dry will help the children learn the difference. We will also have fun singing songs like "*If All the Raindrops*", "*Rain, Rain go Away*", and "*Mr. Sun*". Lastly, we have so many milestones we are working on in our classroom like sitting up, crawling, walking, eating solid food, and babbling. We cannot wait to see what happens next in your child's development!

Family Connection:

We all enjoy watching our birds out the window. We count them, talk about their colors, and talk about what they are doing. It would be fun to see pictures of your child watching the birds at your feeders and in your yard. If you don't have any feeders, it might be fun to add one to your yard and put it up together.
