Our classroom is a place to explore, learn, and grow. We have a multitude of different learning centers that may interest your child, some of which are: the library, science, arts and crafts, music, construction, writing, dramatic play, and theater. Activities and materials will change periodically. There are quiet areas for your child to use, as well as an area to work on homework. There will be a variety of activities planned each month around a theme that reflects our student's interests. Outside play will be offered daily, weather permitting, so please have appropriate outdoor clothing and outerwear available for your child. These items should be labeled with your child's name to avoid confusion about who they belong to. There are a few items that we do not allow in the classroom: toys from home, Pokemon cards, cellphones, gum, and candy. Personal items should stay in backpacks. Art supplies, games, books, and educational materials are welcome. While at the center we expect children to play in a safe manner, follow the rules, be respectful to staff and peers, and have appropriate interactions.
