## Our 3K Room!

We are very excited to have your child with us this year. This will be a year filled with exploration, friendship, discovery and growth.

Our curriculum is based on helping children, in the early years, to acquire social competence and skills they will need to become successful, life-long learners. Our room is set up into a variety of learning areas. These areas include; math, science, art, music, dramatic play, small manipulative, sensory and blocks. Your child will have the opportunity each day to explore all the areas of interest.

Our first unit will be "All About Me", while we are getting to know our room and each other. We will then move into our study of trees, which will include, foods grown on a tree, animals that live in a tree and things that we make from a tree.

#### Drop Off/Pick Up

When you arrive with your child each day, just give our classroom door a knock and we will be there to greet you both. Do the same at the end of our day, unless we are on the playground. Then you may walk through the room to the playground door to pick up your child.

#### Question of the Day?

Each day we will have a new question on the dry erase board, which is located outside our classroom door. Please read it with your child each morning and have them place their name under their answer. The question and responses are discussed every day during our "Morning Meeting".

# Apple Basket

The apple basket is located on the outside of our classroom door. Every morning your child can find the apple with their name on it and place it in the basket. This is a fun way to welcome your child and promote name recognition.

This will allow me to send out quick reminders throughout the day as needed.
