Hello Families,

The school year is right around the corner! I would like to welcome those of you who are here for the first time and those who are returning to the School-Age 2 room at Lakeland's Little Learners. I am excited to have everyone here and cannot wait for the school year to start!

Our classroom is a place to explore, learn, and grow. We have a multitude of different learning centers that may interest your child, some of which are: the library, science, arts and crafts, music, construction, writing, and dramatic play. Activities and materials will change periodically. There are quiet areas for your child to use, as well as an area to work on homework. There will be a variety of activities planned each month around a theme that reflects student's interests. Outside play will be offered daily, weather permitting, so please have appropriate outdoor clothing and outerwear available for your child. These items should be labeled with your child's name to avoid confusion about who they belong to. There are a few items that we do not allow in the classroom: toys from home, Pokemon cards, cellphones, gum, and candy. Personal items should stay in backpacks. Art supplies, games, books, and educational materials are welcome. Those who bring these items are responsible for them. While at the center we expect children to play in a safe manner, follow the rules, be respectful to staff and peers, and have appropriate interactions.

❖ Please make contact with the office via phone or email if your child is going to be absent or there are schedule changes. On days off of school please make arrangements with the office, being added to the schedule is not automatic.

❖ When dropping off/picking up please make contact with the teacher. All children should be accompanied by an adult.
