We are pleased that you and your child will be joining our LLL family. Here are a few reminders that parents have found helpful.

When dropping off your child in the morning please fill out your child's Daily Sheet on the classroom door and wash your child's hands.

When picking up your child please take home all bottles and food containers to be washed.

At the end of the week please take home your child's sleep sack and blanket to be laundered.

We provide snacks and milk with snack at no charge. Children over 12 months are served whole milk with lunch and snacks. Children over 2 years received skim milk. If you would like us to provide milk with your child's cold lunch, there is a fee of \$0.25/day. If you would like your child to eat our hot lunch please notify the office.

SUPPLIES

Please label all supplies.

Diaper Bag – Please provide a reusable bag to place your child's belongings in. Please do not send any plastic bags or bags with long handles as these are choking hazards. Please do not leave medicines, ointments, or hazardous objects in your child's bag.

Diapers & Wipes – These may be stored in the infant room. Wipes must be stored in a hard plastic container. FYI – Health and safety procedures for diapering requires us to use at a minimum 3 wipes per diaper change.

Lotion/Powder/Ointment – These may be stored in the infant room in a locked box. In order to do so, you must complete a pink medication administration form.

Bedding - Children under I year of age must sleep in a sleep sack. The sheet for your child's crib will be provided and laundered by the center. You must provide an appropriate sized non-swaddling sleep sack for your child, as well as a crib sized blanket for when your child might go in a bouncer or on the floor.

Extra Clothes – Please provide two extra sets to be kept in your child's cubbie. Please replace as seasons and sizes change.

Formula, Breast Milk, & Food – All food & drink must be labeled with your child's first and last name and the date. We recommend using permanent marker. You may like a silicone bottle label such as the orbit labels made by Inchbug.

***If you forget to bring diapers, wipes, or bedding the center will provide them for your child at a cost of:
