### Leprechaun Planters

### Wind Catchers



This tool tells you which direction the wind is blowing from, which can indicate whether the weather is likely to get warmer, cooler, wetter, or dryer. In the northern hemisphere, if the wind is from the north, the weather will get colder. If it's from the south, it will get warmer. From the east means rain or snow is coming. From the west means the weather may clear.
