Themes for September 2023

1. Getting To Know You Surveys (Student and parent surveys) (Language, Literacy, and Numeracy, Social Emotional Development/Character Education)

With these surveys, parents and students will be able to help the staff get a better understanding of each child and what parents want for them from our program.

2. Outside Group Games (Social Emotional Development/Character Education, Health and Wellness)

All students will be given several opportunities to work with their new peers during group cooperation games. Such games include relay races, dodgeball, football, soccer, and four-square.

3. All About Me Portraits (Arts and Culture, Media and Technology, Service Learning, STEM)

Students will first have the opportunity to use the projector to trace an outline of themselves based off a picture taken the first day of attendance. Once an outline is drawn, students can decorate themselves using art materials. Lastly, students can inform everyone of their personal favorites (i.e.. food, activity, etc..) by filling out index cards that will be posted around their decorated portrait.

4. Wrap-Around Program Tour (Language, Literacy, and Numeracy, STEM, Health and Wellness)
