Important Information

- ❖ We work on potty training in this room! We try to go every hour, most of the children are still in pull-ups but are doing a great job! Please send reattachable pull ups and spare clothes.
- ❖ Please do not send toys from home, unless they are stuffed animals for nap time.
- ❖ If the weather is nice, (weather permitting – feels like temp over 0 degrees and 100 degrees feel like) we will be going outside twice a day. Please make sure that your child has closed-toed shoes and everything needed to be warm. (Hats, mittens, winter jacket)
- ❖ Upon arrival, please assist your child with washing their hands. The proper procedure is: Wet hands, lather with soap for 20 seconds (singing ABC or Happy Birthday is perfect), rinse hands, dry hands with a paper towel, turn water off with a paper towel.
- ❖ Please label all your child's belongings, including their water bottles. Feel free to bring a water bottle for your child to drink out of throughout the day. Thank you for labeling, it gets tricky to keep track of everything and we don't want anything sent to the wrong home.
